

VHSL 2012 Writing/Photography/Design Journalism Contest Results

A total of 1,046 examples of outstanding scholastic journalism – writing, photography and design – are recognized in VHSL’s 2012 competition for magazine, newspaper and yearbook journalists. They were selected from entries submitted by 49 different student publications. Judging was based first on meeting standards for outstanding journalism then top entries were ranked on the basis of quality in each category by VHSL group.

Fewer awards in some categories reflect low participation in those categories.

Certificates of achievement were presented to all winners in October.
